

Safety Share: Steps To Safe Lifting And Handling Using proper lifting techniques can help

prevent back injuries both on and off the job. Follow these tips to avoid compressing the spinal discs or straining your lower back when you are lifting:

- Keep a wide base of support. Your feet should be shoulder-width apart, with one foot slightly ahead of the other
- Squat down, bending at the hips and knees only.
- Keep good posture. Look straight ahead, and keep your back straight, your chest out, and your shoulders back.
- Slowly lift by straightening your hips and knees (not your back). Keep your back straight, and don't twist as you lift.
- Hold the load as close to your body as possible, at the level of your belly button. • Use your feet to change direction,
- taking small steps. • Lead with your hips as you change
- direction. Keep your shoulders in line with your hips as you move.
- Set down your load carefully, squatting with the knees and hips only.
